#### 1 Intended Use

The Brushing head ensures a fast and accurate stripping of all commercially available flat or square wires from 0.5 to about 6mm in thickness. It is also possible to remove insulation of enamel wire of high number multiple strands. With the infinitely adjustable brushes faultless, clean wire ends are achieved.



#### INDICATION!

The device may be used solely for the materials approved by the manufacturer. Any other use is not permitted!



#### DANGER!

For injuries and damages caused by failure to observe the safety instructions, or due to improper actions, the manufacturer disclaims any liability with regard to operational safety and personal injury

#### 1.1 Limitation of liability

The Brushing head has been tested by the manufacturer before delivery. The electrical installation of the device must be carried out by a competent person and must be monitored.




Image 1: Brushing head

#### 3 Delivery contents

Before you start to use your Brushing head, please make sure that your delivery is complete and agrees with the information on the delivery note.

#### 3.1 Damage report

After delivery of the Brushing head any damage due to defective packaging or transport must be reported to the hauler, the insurance and the delivery work. For contact adress see chapter 6.3.

#### 4 Installation guide

#### 4.1 Unpacking

- Carefully remove the packaging.
- Check the Brushing head for any obvious damage.



#### INDICATION!

- Check the delivery for its completeness based on the delivery note. (Should it not be complete, please contact our customer service immediately).
- In case of any damage due to defective packaging or transport, contact our customer service, the hauler and the insurance.

#### 4.2 Construction and installation

If the Wire Stripper is mounted on the bracket (accessory), it must be installed so that a proper function is guaranteed, i.e. it may not result in unacceptable static, dynamic, or thermal stresses acting on the Wire Stripper.

The bracket must stand on a firm, even and vibration free surface and be easily accessible for the operator.



#### **DANGER!**

The Brushing head may not be exposed to vibration and /or oscillations. These may affect not only the operation, they can also lead to disturbances or accidents!

#### 4.3 Commissioning

Note that when you first start and test run it must be ensured that...

- all installations comply with local regulations,
- all power and control connections are connected and ready for operation,
- all parts are clean and free from dirt,

#### **DANGER!**

If the ISOMAP IIB drive and accessories, safety devices, etc. are not testet properly, the funktion can be affected and serious injouries to personell and/or massive damage to the Brushing head can occur!



#### **CAUTION!**

- When commissioning personal protective equipment (goggles and gloves) must be used at all times!
- The rules to prevent accidents as well as the EKAS directives (for work in Switzerland) must be followed.



#### **INDICATION!**

The user must have read and understood the Short Guide and all the rules.

#### **Operation**

#### Mounting on ISOMAP IIB drive 5.1

Line up flat side of the shaft (1) to the flat sleeve of the Brushing head (2) and carefully slide together till the threads (3) meet. Slowly mount the Brushing head by carefully turning to the end of the tread. Be sure that the Brushing head is level with the ISOMAP IIB drive!




Image 2: Mounting Brushing head



#### 5.2 Adjusting the Brushes



1	Set screw to secure the End stop
2	End stop, turnable for longer wire ends
3	Adjustment screw to adjust the wire diameter
4	Security plate

#### **DANGER!**

The tool has extreme force!



#### **INDICATION!**

Use of the tool without the ISOMAP IIB drive is not intended. If the tool anyhow is used with another drive, it's important to note the direction of rotation!

#### 5.3 Rough tuning of the Brushing head

1	ON/OFF switch on OFF	
2	Loosen set screw (1) a bit	
3	Adjust End stop (2) to desired length, turnable for longer wire ends!	
4	Insert a wire through the security plate (4) and adjust the brushes with the adjustm screw (3) so that they touch the wire without pressure.  Continue with fine tuning

#### **INDICATION!**

The setting of the average thickness may only be made in electricity free condition.

#### 5.4 Fine tuning the Brushing head

1	Run a wire centred between the brushes, turn on the device and pull the insulation of		
2	If the insulation does not come off, turn the adjustment screw (3) to the right		
3	If however the wire is blocked, turn the screw to the left until the wire can be pulled back and the insulation can be removed easily.		



#### **CAUTION!**

Minimize the revolutions to reduce the risk of the wire getting pulled back to hard.



#### **CAUTION!**

It is particularly important to ensure that no hard objects (e.g. screwdrivers) get into the turning brushes. If objects get into the Brushing head while the motor is running there is an acute risk of accidents! Also the Brushing head is damaged.

#### 5.5 Stripping wire ends



#### **CAUTION!**

• When operating the ISOMAP IIB drive with the Brushing head personal protective equipment (goggles and gloves and possibly a mask) must be used.

1	ON/OFF switch on OFF
2	Slide wire into the designated opening
3	Hold wire firmly
4	ON/OFF switch on ON
5	Pull wire slowly out of the opening
6	ON/OFF switch on OFF

#### DANGER!

- Removing the security plate is strictly prohibited!
- Before operating the ISOMAP IIB drive with the Brushing head:
   Make sure the End stop is mounted!
- Operating the device without a security plate and the End stop is prohibited!
- When manufacturing wires, the device must be mounted on the bracket!



#### **INDICATION!**

For more frequent and prolonged use (for example manufacturing wires) it's appropriate to wear a respirator mask.

#### 6 Maintenance



#### **INDICATION!**

- Do not use hazardous materials for cleaning.
- Do not use any aggressive cleaners.



- Cleaning foam is very aggressive and should therefore only be used on rust free parts. Painted parts, parts made of aluminium, rubber gaskets, engines, transmissions and electrical components must be protected from foam.
- Perform the cleaning always without electricity connected.
- Wear appropriate personal protective equipment (goggles, gloves, and a mask).



• Do not store food or drinks near the Brushing head during the process of cleaning.

The Brushing head is constructed in accordance with applicable satutory recuirements and is safe to operate. The device still contains risks, if operated improperly or not in proper condition.

#### 6.1 System maintenance

Note that when cleaning the following items, it must be ensured that...

- For cleaning the Brushing head only suitable cleanser may be used!
- The Brushing head must be cleaned regularly!

#### 6.2 Cleaning of the Brushing head

It is important that the Brushing heads are free from the fine metal dust.



#### INDICATION!

- The need for maintenance or service is determined by regular visual inspection, especially in the initial phase of every operation.
- The listed checks / maintenance work might not be complete, they are merely recommended by Isomap AG. The list must be adapted to the operational realities!
- Isomap AG takes no responsibility for any damage due to the lack of instructions in the maintenance plan.
